

**John 10:17-18 &
Isaiah 53:3-10 &
Romans 3:23-25 &
Romans 8:32-39**

Jesus initiates the New Covenant (God-Promise) by willingly laying down his life. Jesus tells Pilate & the Jewish leaders that He is the Son of God, and that God has given them authority at this moment to carry out His execution on the cross. Jesus is crucified, dies, and is buried in a nearby tomb. All His disciples flee except a few women, John, and two religious leaders who were secret followers .



GOD: He fulfills all of His past God-promises in the death of the Son. Jesus gives His life as a ransom for many. God puts the punishment of humans' sin on Jesus.

HUMANS: Our sins have to be punished; Jesus takes on that punishment in our place.

Remember: This is a true story: Jesus came to die.

Why did Jesus come to die?

What did God achieve for sinners like us in sending his Son to die?

To Show the WEALTH of God's Love & GRACE for Sinners – Romans 5:7–8 & Ephesians 1:7

To FORGIVE Sin – Isaiah 43:25 & Psalm 103:12 & Matthew 26:28 & Acts 10:43

To BECOME my RIGHTEOUSNESS – Romans 5:19 & 2 Corinthians 5:21 & Philippians 3:9

To Take Away our CONDEMNATION – Romans 8:1 & Romans 8:34

To Make Us HOLY, BLAMELESS, and PERFECT – Colossians 1:19–22 & Hebrews 10:14

To Bring us BACK (RECONCLIE US) to God – Romans 5:10 & 2 Corinthians 5:19–20

To Give ETERNAL LIFE to all Who BELIEVE on Him – John 3:16
